For an activity in this category to count for both the NCC and the BCC, it must be non-coaching-specific and include topics such as when to refer, scope of practice, dual relationships, distinguishing between professions, etc.

Please note: Each certification board will conduct an independent review and has the right to deny programs that do not meet the criteria.
